Dear Parent/Caregiver,

At Koorana Education Support Centre we are very proud of the educational program that we offer our students, building independence skills so they can contribute as active members of the community. Our parent community is an integral part of this, as we all work together to achieve our common goals for the children.

One change we have made this year is to introduce a change in the contribution rate, \$60 for the first child, \$40 for the second and \$40 for each subsequent child in the family.

We would ask for all families to pay their contribution of \$60 as early in the year as possible. Flexible payment plans are offered for these payments and parents can pay off the amount over the school year as is convenient.

SCHEDULE OF CHARGES
